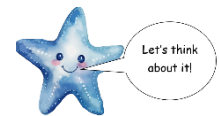
This week we are thinking all about **shape**. In your family can you complete some of these home learning challenges?

Curious Crab



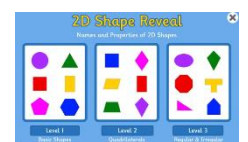
A famous artist called Kandinsky loved painting pictures using shapes. Can you make a picture using lots of different shapes and colours? You could give it a title and sign you name on it like a famous artist would.

Trying Turtle

Can you make shapes fit together to make a pattern or a picture? This is called tessellation and can be quite tricky but if you keep on trying you will be able to make lots of different shape pictures. You could use Lego, paper shapes or wooden blocks to make your tessellated pictures.

Can you play this shape game? What shape is being hidden and revealed? Can you name the shape and talk about how many sides and corners the shape has? Maybe you could test the rest of your family to see how good they are at recognising shapes!
