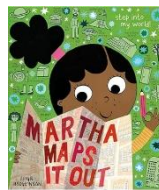

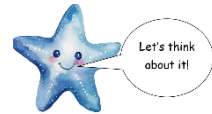

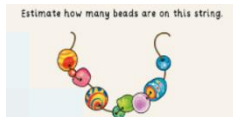

### Curious Crab

Have you ever looked up at the sky at night time? Some people use special maps to help them understand the stars and planets in the sky. ### Trying Turtle



In our maths learning this week we have been learning to estimate amounts. This is an important maths skill to develop understanding about the number system. Can you guess how many you have by taking a handful of pasta shapes or Lego bricks? Is it more than 10 or fewer than 10? Make a sensible guess and then check by counting.

### Solving starfish

Can you make a map showing all the places that are important to you near your home? Maybe you live near some shops, family members or a park. You can think about how best to design it. Try writing labels on each of the places to show what it is.
