This week we have been sharing the book Hurray for Hoppy. Can you use your knowledge of superheroes to design a superhero rabbit? What would their superpower be?

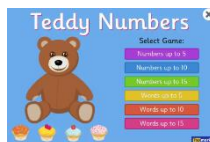
What will their superhero costume include? Can you give your superhero rabbit a brilliant superhero name?

## Solving starfish

Can you make a superhero fly? Try this experiment using balloons.

### Flying Superheroes

Science Experiment



#### Method

1. Draw a face on the balloons with permanent marker.
2. Blow up the balloons but do not tie them off. Keep the opening closed with your hand.
3. Using the sticky tape, attach some tissue to the slimmer end of the balloon to make a cape.
4. Let go of the balloon and watch it whizz around the room.

#### You will need:

- Balloons
- Black permanent marker
- Coloured tissue paper
- Sticky tape
