This week we are thinking all about **Superheroes**

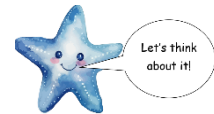
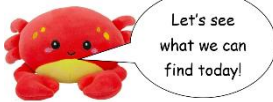
In your family can you complete some of these home learning challenges?

Do you have a code word or code number that helps you catch the baddies?

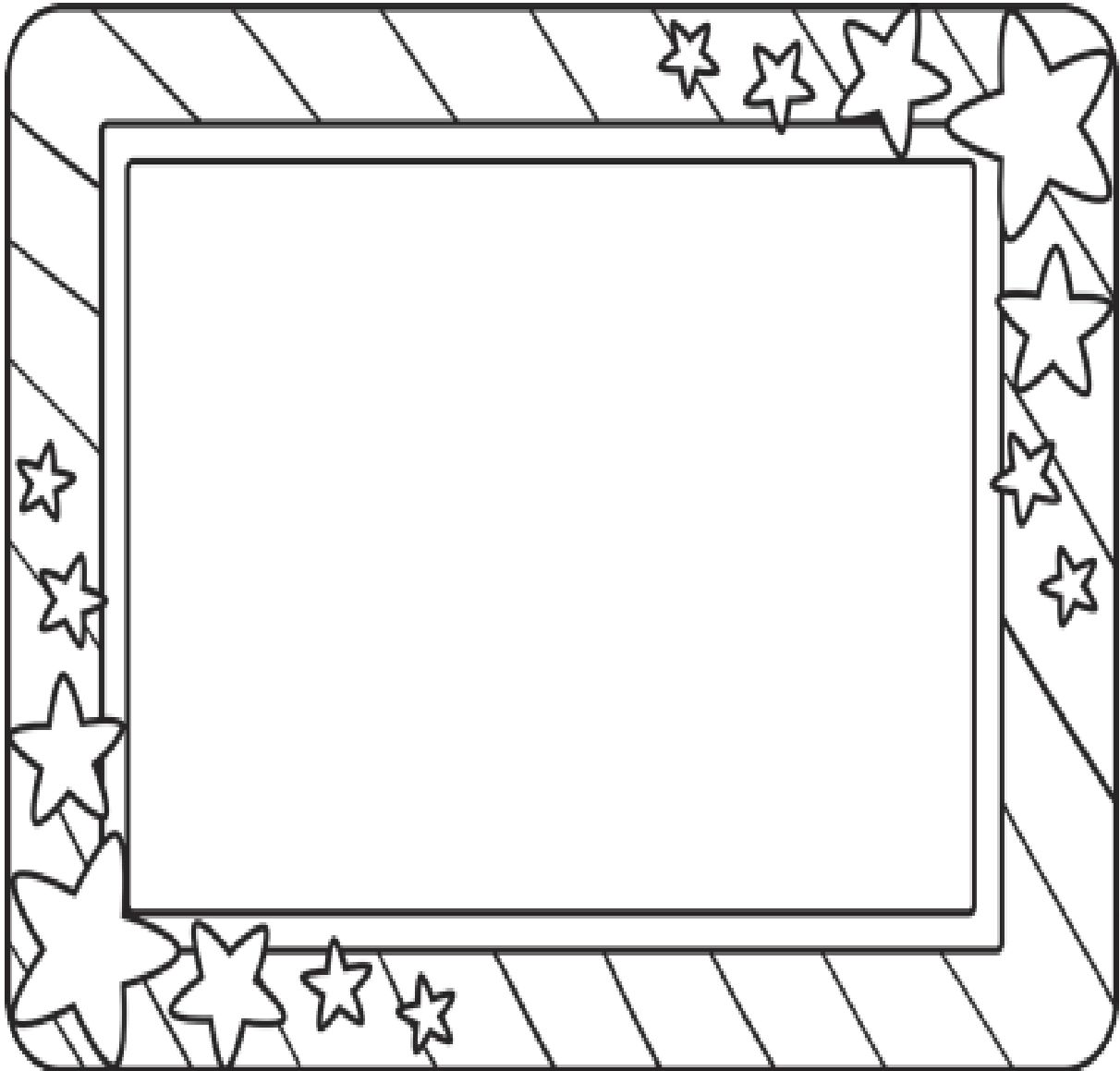


Our **phonics** sounds that we have learnt to read and write in school this week are **ll** and **ss**
