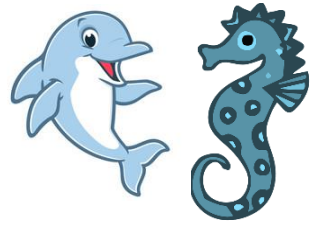


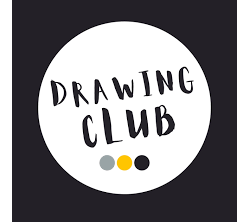
Year R: Our Learning

Curious Crab

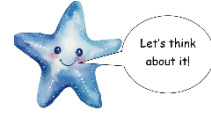
