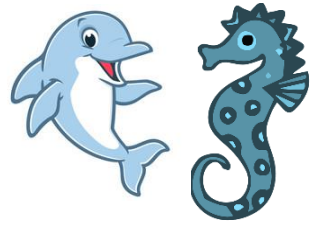


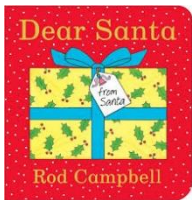
# Year R: Our Learning
