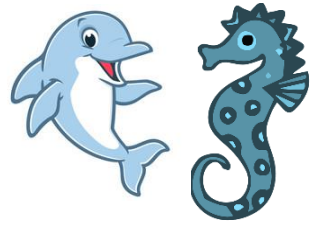


Year R: Our Learning
