Can you think of a sea creature and design a new home for it?

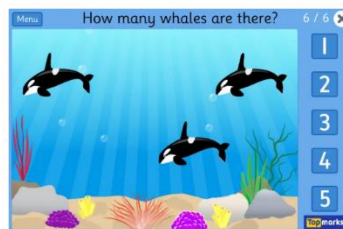

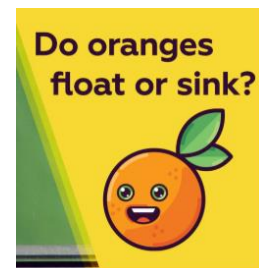
