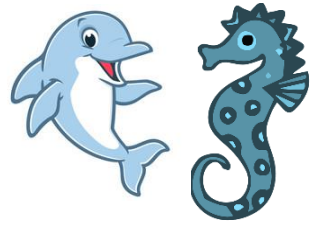


# Year R: Our Learning

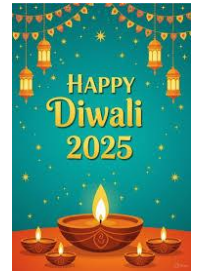


## Messages for Parents/Carers



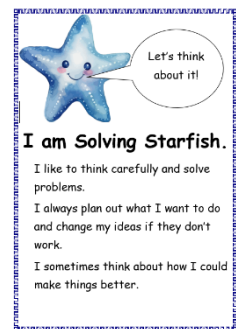
