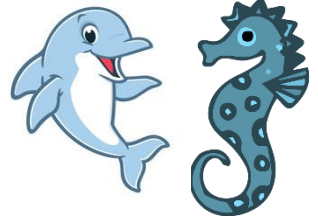


Year R: Our Learning

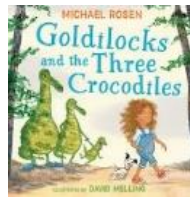


This week we are thinking all about **Goldilocks and the three crocodiles**.

We can't wait to see how much fun you have learning about **Goldilocks** at home!

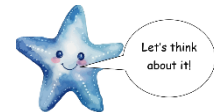
