## Broken Weeks

A "broken week" is any week where a child misses one or more school sessions (a morning, an afternoon, or a full day). Even one missed session means the week is no longer a full week of learning.

We are increasingly seeing families extend holidays by taking the first day or two of term, or the last day or two before a break. When this happens, absence rises sharply, and children miss out on really important parts of school life.

At the start of every half term, those first days are when we reset routines, settle classes, rebuild friendships and help children feel calm and ready for learning. Missing these days makes it much harder for children to settle back in, and it can take some pupils a long while to feel confident again.

At the end of term, learning does not stop early. Alongside curriculum learning, children take part in activities that build social skills, teamwork, confidence and independence. These days help them finish the term positively and feel proud of what they have achieved.

When children miss the first or last days of term, it creates a broken week, and broken weeks have a big impact on attendance and on how settled children feel.

Please avoid extending holidays at either end of term. Every session in school matters, not just for academic learning but for friendships, routines, confidence and wellbeing.

If you ever want to talk about attendance or how we can support your child, we are always here to help.
