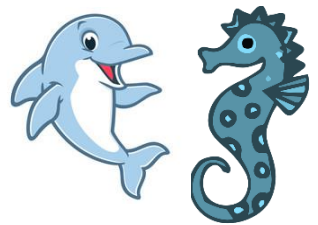


Year R: Our Learning

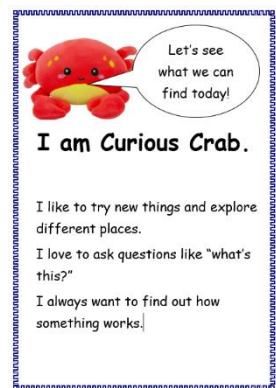


Messages for Parents/Carers

Characteristics of Learning.

In Year R we follow the Early Years Curriculum focussing on learning through play and exploration. We will be using three special characters to develop this over the year. Each character is linked to a different way of learning, thinking and exploring. The first character we have introduced is **Curious Crab**. Being like Curious Crab means the children explored new things in their play, were willing to have a go and were independent in their learning.
