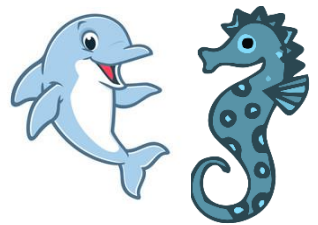


Year R: Our Learning

This week we are thinking all about **Little Red Riding Hood**. In your family can you complete some of these home learning challenges?

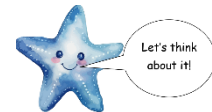
